

## **Heliport Conditional Determination**

Heliport Proposal, William Reeve Hales Alpine Springs Helicopters Heliport 42 31 47 S 172 46 39 E 370 Woodbank Road, Hanmer Springs

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from William Reeve Hales Notice of a Heliport Proposal, conducted an Aeronautical Study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate. After completing the Aeronautical Study I am satisfied that the proposed action will not adversely affect the safety of persons or property on the ground, but may impact the safe and efficient use of airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- All operations at the Alpine Spring Helicopters Heliport must be conducted in accordance with any land use resource consent conditions issued by the Hurunui District Council, and must also report any non-compliances to the consent to the Hurunui District Council: and
- All helicopter operations within the vicinity of the heliport must be in accordance with CAR Part 91.127 (Use of aerodromes); and
- Alpine Spring Helicopters are to contact Hanmer Aerodrome, their Aerodrome
  User Group, Amuri Helicopters Ltd and Skydiving Kiwi's Limited to ensure an
  awareness of others' operations in the vicinity is facilitated; and
- Alpine Spring Helicopters must develop approach and departure procedures to/from the heliport to ensure that any overlapping circuit operations with Hanmer Aerodrome (NZHM) do not conflict; and

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

- The heliport is maintained to the safety design standards published in CAA Advisory Circular AC139-8. In addition, the heliport should install a windsock; and
- The heliport is to ensure appropriate fencing and signage is maintained around the perimeter of all operational areas of the heliport; and
- Alpine Springs Helicopters is to provide CAA with an annual report of traffic movement data for Alpine Springs Heliport, in accordance with CAR Part 139.505 (a).

This Conditional Determination shall become void on 29 July 2022
