

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Agtrans Limited – Crane at Fonterra Whareroa, 84 Whareroa Rd, Hawera

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Agtrans Ltd notification of intention to operate a 105m high crane at the Fonterra Whareroa site, 84 Whareroa Rd, Hawera, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must be fitted with obstacle lighting in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule part 77, Appendix B. Lights must be fitted to the top of the crane and the end of the boom. Lighting must be operational at all times; and
- 2. Agtrans are to inform Aeropath Ltd at https://www.aeropath.aero/ of the actual commencement of works to allow for the promulgation of a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) to inform pilots of the increase in MSA to en-route procedures Y738 and Y198; and
- 3. Agtrans are to inform Aeropath Ltd at https://www.aeropath.aero/ when the crane has completed the operation and is no longer on site so that the MSA can be returned to normal; and
- 4. CAA must be notified when crane operations cease at the end of the project.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 01 March 2021 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
