

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 28 - 32 Churchill Street, Kaikoura.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Fire and Emergency New Zealand, notification of intention to erect a permanent communication mast at a structure located at 28-32 Churchill Street, Kaikoura, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The communication mast is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light; and
- 2. The communication mast height is not to exceed 13.6m AGL; and
- 3. Fire and Emergency NZ is to alert the operator of the helipad, Kaikoura Medical Centre 03-319 3500 of the installation of the mast.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 5th August 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 26th February 2024.

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 188 Victoria Street, Hamilton.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Foster Group Limited, notification of intention to operate two tower cranes at 188 Victoria Street, Hamilton, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The cranes shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light as stated in the Civil Aviation Rule Part 77 proposal; and
- 2. Foster Group Limited is to request an extension from CAA (Quote 22/77/75 aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) of this Determination at least 30 days prior to the expiry date; and
- 3. Foster Group Limited shall advise the CAA Quote 22/77/75 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the cranes operating at the Victoria Street site are lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 26th August 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 26th February 2024.

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 84 Buckley Avenue, Hobsonville Point, Auckland.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from ASPEC Construction Limited, notification of intention to erect a crane at 84 Buckley Avenue, Hobsonville Point, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be lit at the highest point at all times in accordance with CAA Rule Part 77 Appendix B; and
- 2. The crane is not to exceed 46.25m AMSL; and
- 3. When the crane operating at the Buckley Avenue site is lowered and no longer in use, ASPEC Construction Limited is to notify CAA (Quote 22/77/74 aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz); and
- 4. When the crane operating at the Buckley Avenue site is lowered and no longer in use, ASPEC Construction Limited is to notify RNZAF Base Operations, Auckland.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 26th August 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 26th February 2024 or when the crane is lowered and no longer in use, whichever is earlier.
