

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION. 60 Oxford Terrace, Christchurch.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Titan Cranes Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 60 Oxford Terrace, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is lit with an appropriate obstacle light at the top of the boom as stated in the Part 77 Proposal; and
- 2. Titan Cranes Limited is to advise the CAA Quote 22/77/82 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane operating at the Oxford Terrace site is no longer required.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 28th July 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 28th January 2024 or when the crane is lowered and no longer in use, whichever is earlier.
