# Exemption from the Requirements in Civil Aviation Rules CAR 121.71(h)(2) and CAR 125.77(d)(3)

PURSUANT TO Section 37 of the Civil Aviation Act 1990,

- I, Russell Kilvington, Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that—
  - (a) The requirements in CARs 121.71(h)(2) and 125.77(d)(3) relating to minimum runway strip widths for Code 3 and 4 aeroplanes are clearly unreasonable or inappropriate in the case of operations at Wellington Airport; and
  - (b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

### HEREBY EXEMPT-

## holders of air operator certificates who operate Code 3 or 4 aeroplanes

### FROM-

the requirements in Civil Aviation Rules CAR121.71 (h)(2) and CAR125.77(d)(3) requiring a holder of a air operator certificate to ensure that each aeroplane it operates does not use any place for landing or taking off unless, in the case of a Code 3 or 4 aeroplane, the runway strip width is not less than 300 metres at an international aerodrome,

### ONLY WITH RESPECT TO

operations at Wellington Airport by Code 3 or 4 aeroplanes.

This exemption shall remain in effect unless withdrawn in writing by the Director.
