



Fox Heliport Conditional Determination

Heliport Proposal, Totally Tourism Ltd, Fox Heliport

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 157 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Totally Tourism Ltd Notice of Heliport Proposal, conducted an Aeronautical Study in consultation with such persons, representative groups and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the Aeronautical Study I am satisfied that the proposed action will not adversely affect the safety of persons or property on the ground but may impact the safe and efficient use of airspace and traffic circuits.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

CONDITIONAL DETERMINATION

in respect of the Notice of Proposal. The following conditions are specific to this Determination:


- The safety design guidance and recommendations published in CAA Advisory Circular AC139-8 should be considered in the heliport design and operation; and
- Due to the close proximity of the two heliports, Totally Tourism Ltd should develop procedures in its Safety Management System to ensure ongoing communications, coordination and safe operations with NZFR are maintained.
- Totally Tourism Ltd should likewise encourage NZFR to develop procedures in their Safety Management System to ensure ongoing communications, coordination and safe operations with NZFH are maintained.
- Totally Tourism Ltd should ensure that all users of the current NZFH are aware that the heliport is to be relocated to the new location.
- Totally Tourism Ltd should ensure that its helicopter operators are familiar with the equipment and operating requirements within the MBZ.
- Totally Tourism Ltd should also establish and maintain ongoing contact with all other heli-tourism operators operating in the MBZ to ensure awareness of everybody's operations is maintained.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

- Totally Tourism Ltd should work with the heliport operator of NZFR to provide AIM Aeropath with clear guidance on the required AIP entry for NZFR and NZFH.
- Totally Tourism Ltd should consider the effects of any nearby obstacles infringing the OLS in accordance with AC139-8, and mitigate the risks of these obstacles as appropriate, including the removal of vegetation of the new NZFH site and any obstacles at NZFR that may present a risk; and
- Totally Tourism Ltd is to provide the CAA with an annual report of traffic movement data for the Fox Heliport, in accordance with CAR Part 139.505(a).

Unless the Determination Conditions are actioned prior, this Conditional Determination shall become void on 19 December 2026.
