

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: The Fletcher Construction Company Ltd - Crawler Crane North West Shopping Mall, Massey, Auckland

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from The Fletcher Construction Company Ltd, notification of intention to operate a crawler crane above 60 metres, to a maximum height of 65 metres above ground level, at the North-West Shopping Centre in Massey, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane must be equipped with a red obstruction light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B at all times; and
- 2. The CAA is to be advised of the commencement of the crane operation above 60 metres AGL at least five days in advance of such operations; and
- A NOTAM and/or AIP Supplement advising pilots of the increased MDA for the NZWP VOR/DME RWY 03 is to be issued prior to the crane commencing operations above 60 metres; and
- 4. The CAA is to be advised of the cessation of crane operations above 60 metres; and
- 5. The crane must not operate above 65 metres AGL at any time.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 24th day of February 2016 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
