



NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION:

First Principles Constructors Limited – Corner of Browning Street and Campbell Road, Tokoroa.

Coordinates: 38° 14' 37.6" S, 175° 52' 57.1" E

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from First Principles Constructors Limited notification of intention to operate cranes at the Corner of Browning Street and Campbell Road, Tokoroa, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The Tower crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light as stated in the Part 77 proposal; and
2. First Principles Constructors Limited shall notify Aeropath, Quote 25/77/21 (part77@aeropath.aero) when the cranes have been lowered and are no longer in use; and
3. First Principles Constructors Limited shall notify the CAA, Quote 25/77/21 (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the cranes are removed off site and no longer required.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder.



This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 29 November 2024 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 29 May 2026 or when the cranes are no longer required and removed off site, whichever is earlier.
