

## NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 43 Cedar Terrace, Stanmore Bay, Auckland.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from HEB Construction Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 43 Cedar Terrace, Stanmore Bay, Auckland conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

## DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. The crane is to be lit with an appropriate obstacle light as stated in the proposal; and
- 2. The crane is not to exceed 61m AGL; and
- 3. HEB Construction Limited is to advise the CAA (Quote 2025-00485 to <u>aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</u>) when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2025 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026.
