

Appendix 2. Limitations, Conditions and Variations list and classes

The following is a list of limitation, conditions, restrictions that are to be displayed based on the Class applied for.

| Code | Standard or common Endorsement Text | Applicable Classes |

| 001 | Vision correction (spectacles or contacts) as tested must be worn | 1,2,3 |
| 004 | Reading correction to be available | 1,2,3 |
| 006 | Contact lenses must be worn | 1,2,3 |
| 007 | Spare spectacles must be readily available | 1,2,3 |
| 008 | A single contact lens must be worn, in one eye | 1,2 |
| 011 | Valid only when hearing aids are worn | 1,2,3 |
| 012 | Must carry a bronchodilator inhaler | 1,2,3 |
| 016 | Any accompanying pilot or Air Traffic Controller must be made aware of the holder's medical condition | 1,2,3 |
| 020 | Restricted in accordance with medical directions in letter dated - | 1,2,3 |
| 021 | Not valid for Class 1 single pilot air operations carrying passengers | 1 |
| 024 | Not valid for carriage of passengers | 1,2 |
| 030 | Valid only for flying as or with a qualified co-pilot | 1,2 |
| 034 | Restricted to flying with a safety pilot (Class 2 only) | 2 |
| 040 | Not valid for IFR flights (Class 2 only) | 2 |
| 059 | Subject to medical surveillance as specified in Examiner's letter dated - | 1,2,3 |
| 073 | Protective spectacles must be worn (and if flying open cockpit aircraft, protective goggles not restricting visual field must be worn) | 1,2 |
| 082 | Not valid for flight in the vicinity of a controlled aerodrome (unless the aircraft is in radio contact aerodrome control) | 1,2 |
| 085 | Not valid for night flying | 1,2 |
| 086 | Not valid for aerobatic flight | 1,2 |
| 087 | Not valid for rotary wing operations | 1,2 |

Operational Endorsements must be on the medical certificate.
